Parents have your heard about the drug Fentanyl? This particular drug is quickly becoming a drug of choice across our country and in central Minnesota. The sad reality is that this drug is considered extremely dangerous. Fentanyl is a prescription strength opioid drug that is prescribed for the treatment of chronic and severe pain. Pharmaceutical grade Fentanyl is 50 to 100 times more potent than Morphine. Street versions of this drug are often mixed with other drugs such as heroin, making them even more dangerous. The Becker area, like other areas of the state have observed several overdoses related to the misuse of this drug. Several public safety agencies in Sherburne County now carry the medication Naloxone (or Narcan) to help counter the effects of Fentanyl. The Becker Police Department is currently in communication with CentraCare to train and ultimately carry the drug in each Police car.

Also, parents, as a reminder there is a curfew in Becker, as well as in all of Sherburne County. Each community in Sherburne County in addition to the county areas, have a curfew in place for juveniles. Please remember, this is not a punishment for our youth, rather is a way to ensure that our youth do not become victims of crime, or become involved in a situation where they make someone else a victim. For reference, the Becker curfew is as follows:

15 & under – 10:00pm each night 16 & 17 – midnight each night

There are exceptions such as a school related event, church or employment, however, kids are asked to immediately return home and not stop anywhere in between to avoid any other issues.
