As summer continues many people will be enjoying the excellent walking trails and green space in the City of Becker with their family and pets. This time of year the Becker Police Department has an increased number of animal complaints. I would like to remind everyone that it is against the law to allow an animal to defecate on others private or public property and not clean it up immediately. There have been several reports of dog owners violating these laws throughout Becker's green space including but not limited to; both Cemetery's, Pebble Creek Golf Course, and the Becker City Parks. If caught engaging in such acts, violators can be charged with misdemeanor public nuisance. Violating the state public nuisance law can have fines exceeding \$100. I have attached a list of Becker's animal ordinances and State Statutes that apply. The Officers of the Becker Police Department

Barking Dog

10.06 (12) (4)

Fine - \$50

It is a petty misdemeanor for the owner of any dog to fail to keep the dog from excessively barking, howling, or whining.

Dog at Large

10.06(2)

Fine - \$50

It is a petty misdemeanor for the owner of any dog to permit such animal to run at large.

Dog License Required

10.06(3)

Fine - \$25

It is a petty misdemeanor for any dog owner of a dog six months of age, to fail to obtain a proper City license therefore.

Number of Dogs Restricted

10.06(3)

Court

The number of dogs permitted shall not exceed (3) per dwelling unit.

Animal Defecation Prohibited

10.06 (19)

Court

Any person being the owner of or having charge of any animal not confined to that persons property shall immediately remove any feces deposited on public or private property. Any such person shall have in their possession a means to collect to dispose of all fecal matter in a proper manner.

Public Nuisance (local)

10.44

Fine - \$ 50

Maintaining or permitting a condition which unreasonably annoys, injures, or endangers the safety, health, morals, comfort, or repose of any considerable number of members of the public.

Public Nuisance (state)

609.75

Court

Maintains or permits a condition which unreasonably annoys, injures, or endangers the safety, health, morals, comfort, or repose of any considerable number of members of the public.

Littering (state)

169.42

Court

No person shall throw, deposit, place, or dump, or cause to be thrown, deposited, placed, or dumped upon any street or highway or upon any public or privately owned land adjacent thereto without the owner's consent any snow, ice, glass bottle, glass, nails, tacks, wire, cans, garbage, swill, papers, ashes, cigarette filters, debris from fireworks, refuse, carcass of any dead animal, offal, trash or rubbish or any other form of offensive matter, or any other substance likely to injure any person, animal, or vehicle upon any such street or highway.

Lawn Care

When mowing your yard, make certain that you do not blow grass clippings into the street. When mowing, make the first few passes with the lawnmower blowing the grass clippings into the lawn NOT the street. If there are grass clippings on the street or sidewalk, use a broom or leaf blower to blow them back into the lawn. Do not use a hose to wash them into the street or storm drains. Grass clippings that are blown into the street eventually enter the street storm drain. The grass clippings can form blockages in the storm drains .. Grass clippings contribute nutrients such as nitrogen and phosphorous, which cause unwanted and uncontrolled growth of algae and aquatic weeds in the waterways.

Also, please remember that City Code requires the growth of grass or weeds can be not be over 12 inches in height! Ordinance 10:21 Subd 2., Complete Ordinance is available on city website at www.ci.becker.mn.us . Thank You for your cooperation
